GUIDELINES FOR CLIENTS

SKINWORKS IS FOLLOWING THE GUIDELINES SET FORTH BY THE UTAH STATE HEALTH DEPARTMENT IN THE PERSONAL SERVICES CATEGORY.

CLIENTS WILL BE REQUIRED TO ANSWER THE FOLLOWING:

- 1) Do you have any symptoms of sickness?
 - 2) Have you traveled in the past 14 days?
 - 3) Do you have any sicknesses in your home?
- CLIENTS MUST WEAR MASK AT ALL TIMES, the ONLY exception is when the mask interferes with the service, such as european facial, microderm, etc.
 - Skinworks is staggering appointments to accommodate the guidelines in our lobby, please show for your appointment at the exact time, not early or late. Please do not sit or stand closer than 6 feet with anyone other than those in your household.
 - We are moving towards paperless check-in, once available you may fill out paperwork on your phone or personal computer
 - Skinworks has limited a few things in our services, we apologize for the inconvenience in advance:
 - At the moment, in order to follow guidelines, we can only accommodate 2 pedicures & 1 manicure at a time, we are considering dry pedicures, which will be performed in the treatment room.
 - We are not able to accommodate couples treatments, we can only perform one service in each treatment room, this is for the protection of our students who are not in the same household.
 - We have discontinued steamers in the treatment rooms.

BELOW ARE SOME GUIDELINES THAT SKINWORKS HAS PUT IN PLACE FOR OUR STUDENTS

Skinworks follows Standard Precautions with all of our practices, now and always. We consistently teach our students and employees to use high disinfecting guidelines, not just now but always. We treat all clients & students as if they are infected with every treatment. We continue to follow these guidelines and emphasize the importance of them. We ask and reiterate often that students use their allotted absences for sick time. We also ask that our Spa Clients reschedule their appointments when they are sick.

We want you to feel confident when visiting Skinworks. As a result, we have enhanced some of our procedures in the interest of our Customers', Students' and Employees' health and safety.

- Students MUST wear a mask at all times, unless receiving a service themselves.
- Several times per day we will sanitize door handles, sinks, and common counters.
- Students and employees are monitored by their temperature and asked the same questions clients will be asked. If students or employees show any signs of sickness or answer "YES" to any of the above questions, they will not be allowed into school.
- Students will be limited by small groups attending the school, some will be distance learning, while others are present in the school.
- Students MUST remain 6ft from each other unless providing a service.

We deeply care about our students, our clients, and our community. Anything we can do to prevent the spread of this virus will be taken into action.
