## CONTRAINDICATIONS

- Contagious eye infection (conjunctivitis)
- Stye (an abscess filled with puss caused by staphylococcus bacteria)
- Swelling of the eye
- Claustrophobia

## PRRCARE

- Please arrive to your appointment with no eye makeup on. It will take extra time to remove mascara or any buildup, that will directly affect how many lashes the students are able to place before the appointment is over.

## AFTERCARE

To protect your investment and gain the longest wear from your eyelash extensions, it is important to care for them properly. Lash extensions are attached to the natural lash and can remain in place until the natural lash falls out.

- Do not get your lashes wet for 24 hours. This includes hot steam, so avoid sitting in the sauna during this time frame.
- Do not perm your lashes with extensions on or use any lash curlers.
- Do not rub your lashes vigorously while washing your face use a gentle cloth around your eyes.
- Do not pull, twist or tug at your extensions, this will cause them to fall out faster and may pull out your natural lashes at the same time.
- While it is not recommended, if you do wear mascara, only apply to the bottom lashes.
- Brush and groom your lashes with a clean mascara wand.
- Do not try to remove your own extensions, this may cause damage to your natural lashes. Please contact the school for a removal appointment.
- Schedule a "fill" approximately every 2-4 weeks or as needed. Fills are defined as 15 lashes or less on each eye.
- Avoid any glycol or oil-based makeups, these will affect the glues adhesive and cause your extensions to fall off sooner than desired.

Lash extensions are most appropriate for those who want a naturally glamorous look that requires minimal makeup. Results cannot be guaranteed when incompatible cosmetics are used, or excess wear damages bonding.

## INFO REGARDING SKINWORKS AND OUR EYELASH EXTENSIONS

*Due to Skinworks being a school we like to inform you that eyelash extensions are a learned art. We discount our lashes as a school more than 50% from licensed professionals for this reason. The student doing your lashes is in education mode, because of this they may not last as long as a licensed professional. We thank you for allowing our student to practice on you and as always want to make sure that you have a pleasant experience. If for any reason you have problems with your lashes, please contact the instructor that is working within 48 hours to reschedule a time for you to come in so we may touch up or remove your extensions for you.*
